



Is sexual violence being efficiently addressed in global conflict zones?

K FOREIGN SECRETARY William Hague will use the 2013 Presidency of the G8 to draw attention to the pervasive problem of sexual violence in global con ict zones. @ 25 March, he announced a plan to provide £180m in new funding to support health services in the Democratic Republic of Congo as well as increased efforts to bring perpetrators to justice. A least some portion of the UK's money will be funnelled into NGOs such as the hternational Rescue Committee which distributes 'dignity packages' containing fuel-ef cient stoves and extra clothing to women. The idea is that the risk of sexual violence will decrease if women spend less time searching for rewood and water.
