The Letten Visiting PhD Studentship is aimed at capacity-building for PhD students whose research concerns any aspect of Indian equality and antidiscrimination law. Applications are invited from advanced stage PhD students at any university anywhere in the world (except the LSE) to spend <u>Winter Term</u> <u>2025</u> at the London School of Economics & Political Science's <u>Law School</u> (LSE).

FELLOWSHIP REQUIREMENTS

During their time at LSE, the visitor will be expected to finalise a 10,000-word PhD chapter on any aspect of Indian equality or anti-discrimination law in English, under the mentorship of <u>Professor Tarun Khaitan</u>.

FELLOWSHIP PROVISIONS AND BENEFITS

Funding for the visitorship is provided by <u>the Letten Prize</u> awarded to Professor Tarun Khaitan in 2018. The successful candidate will be reimbursed for the economy class return flight to London from their place of ordinary resi dl (s)5.4mD u&y)-0eTad
