







The [British Journal of Middle Eastern Studies \(BJMES\)](#) is looking for an associate editor who specialises in Iranian Studies. Knowledge of Persian is essential. The job involves assigning referees for articles related to the wider Persianate world and usually in the field of politics, but also on history, art and literature. Once the reviewer reports have been received the associate editor then makes a decision on whether to publish, to request major/minor revisions, or to reject. The average amount of time spent on the process is about five hours per week. But on occasions when the number of submissions rises this may increase.
